

Friend's of Oasis academy :coulsdon

Treasurer Report Sept 2010 to 2011

The Friends of Oasis have supported nine events this year at a cost of £181.44. We have provided refreshments and received small donations from those attending.

Our first Major event was a real money maker, and enjoyed by all. At the Oasis Quiz night the friends took £2070.40. After expenses of £1070.06 we raised a massive £1000.34.

The friends received a donation of a Crystal Palace signed ball. Numbers were sold at the quiz night and through the academy to the students; this however was poorly received and only a total of £50 was raised.

Our May Car boot saw 32 sellers and over 270 visitors. I must say I did not realise how serious the car booters were and may arrived before the FOAC members!! Tea, coffee, bacon sandwiches and hot dogs were sold and the friends raised £405.74 for the Oasis Academy.

The car boot also saw the start of the grand summer draw. Tickets were sold for £1 and a number of great days out and vouchers were up for grabs all of which were kindly donated. Tickets were also sold through the school and at the village fair. We raised £156.22.

The village fair was our last event of the year. The members of FOAC worked hard selling 100 dozen Krispy Kreme donuts, refreshments and fruit pots. We were all please when the last box of donuts finally disappeared along with every single drink and fruit pot. £950 was taken on the day, after expenses the total raised was £450.36. Barclays Bank kindly donated £750 via the match funding scheme although the cheque was not received in time for this years accounts.

Other ongoing fundraising has come from BPRI (£1000) and recycling raising £148.00; £100 reward was given to the children. They chose to spend this on a small party costing £40 and the remaining balance was donated to the Macmillan Cancer Charity. The friends have joined the NCPT at a cost of £105 and have registered for a lottery licence at the cost of £40. This cost will be reduced to £20 if we renew next year.

This year has also seen the closure of two old accounts that were no longer used. A Halifax account held £163.86 and a dormant lottery account containing £1873.68.

In summary the Friend of Oasis Coulsdon have raised a grand total of £2779.22 this year. With this money we have provided Oasis with the following;
