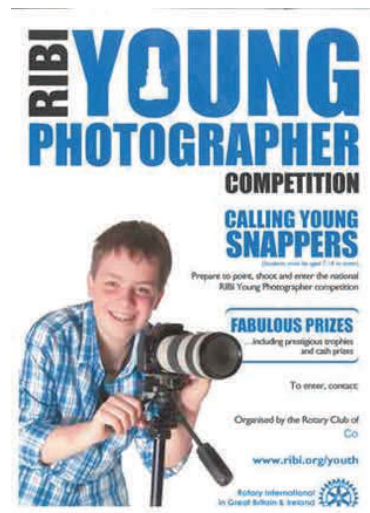

YEAR 7 WON 12:0!

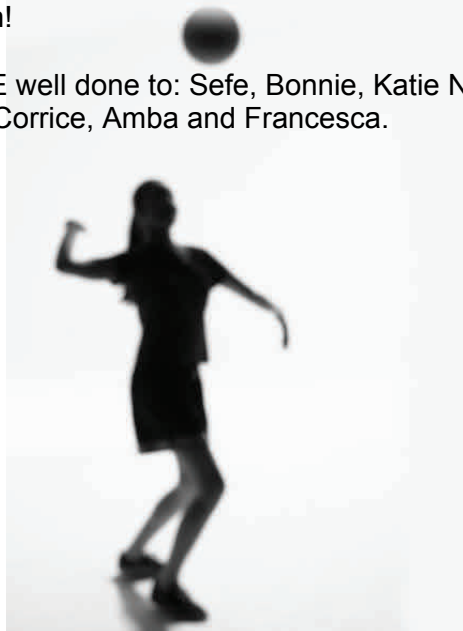
The girls played their socks off and although you could tell that they were getting tired towards the last quarter they still pushed through.
