

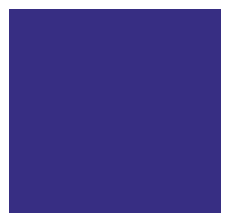
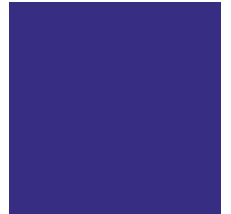
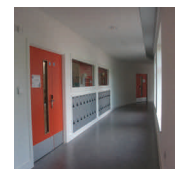
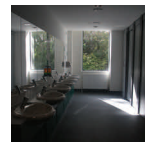
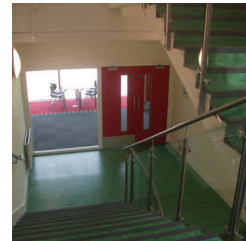
WE ARE IN! PHASE 1 OF MOVE COMPLETED!
