

Dear Year 10 Parents and Carers,

RE: Year 10 Parents' Evening – Thursday 22nd April, 4pm-7pm

I am pleased to be writing to provide information about how the Year 10 remote parents' evening will run.

The appointment gives you the opportunity to discuss your child's progress in what has been an incredibly trying time – it is also important as we move toward Year 11 and thinking ahead toward Post-16 education.

We do ask that every parent makes appointments to keep building on the already strong relationships that staff feel they have with this year group's parents/carers.

We are using the School Cloud system, which we have previously used for booking parents' evening appointments. However, this time we will be using the online meeting function as well as booking system. [Click here](#) to read the step-by-step guide explaining how to log in and book appointments. As with any other parents' evening, we ask that students are present for each five-minute slot you book with their subject teachers. Staff will have their cameras switched on so they can speak to you face to face; please do reciprocate to ensure the meeting is more personal.

You will be able to book appointments from Monday 19th April. You will only be able to select the teachers that your child is taught by. Please note:

- You will not be able to book appointments with mentors. All students had the opportunity to meet their mentor on Friday, 12th February.
- PE will only appear as a choice if your child takes GCSE PE.
- Combined Science students may have more than one teacher. The Science department has allocated one teacher per class to feedback; simply select the teacher that appears as an option.
- There is also an option for another parent/carer to join you on the call – more details in the video guide.

I would also like to take this opportunity to welcome Mr van Gelder to our Year 10 team, as begins working with us as Mrs Dooley finishes for maternity leave. Ms van Gelder has many years of experience supporting Year 11 through their GCSEs, and I am confident this additional support in Year 10 will serve us extremely well.
