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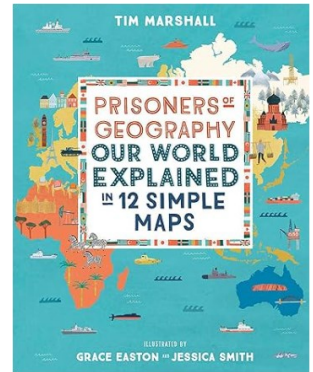
Watch this: Stacey Dooley Investigates - Fashion's Dirty Secrets (Watch with your parent)
