



OAC PE Kit Expectations

Expectations

- Students should attend all lessons in full Academy PE kit ready to practically take part.
- Any student unable to take part physically must have a medical note from a doctor or physio. Students are still expected to bring full PE kit to lessons and get changed unless medical evidence clearly suggests a student can't get changed. It will then be up to the discretion of the PE department as to whether they are asked to change or not.
- Items of kit that are missing or incorrect will result in a de-merit being issued, in line with the Academy policy.
- Any student who refuses to borrow clean lost property kit and take part in the lesson will receive an immediate consequence in line with the Academy policy.

Rationale

The government's policy is that every student should take part in at least 2 hours of physical activity a week. Therefore the PE department expects all students to participate in the lesson whether that is as a participant, official, or coach.

No student should be seen to be opting out of a practical lesson unless they are medically exempt.

As a department our sports leadership programme places a vital role in the development of all our students at the Academy. This includes the social, emotional and physical development of students.

Therefore all students must be changed in full PE kit regardless of illness or injury.
